Award Announcement & Presentation:

The scholarship recipient and all other applicants will be notified of their award status by Monday, June 8, 2025.

The scholarship will be presented during the awards ceremony at the Trevor Tate Memorial Golf Tournament on June 28, 2025.

Eligibility Criteria

To be considered for the Trevor Tate Memorial Scholarship, applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Academic: Applicant must be a graduating senior at Woodward High School in good academic standing.
- **Baseball:** Applicant must have been a member of the Woodward High School baseball team during their senior year.
- **Continued Education:** Applicant must provide proof that they are enrolled or have been accepted to and intend to enroll in an accredited institution of higher learning such as a college, university, trade school, or business school.
- **Character & Leadership:** Applicant must demonstrate sportsmanship, leadership, and involvement at school or in the community.
- **Written Responses:** Applicant must submit short responses to the writing prompts to reflect on how they embody Trevor's selflessness and athletic spirit.

Selection Process

All scholarship submissions will be reviewed by a four-member committee consisting of two representatives from the Tate Family Foundation and two representatives from Woodward High School. To be considered, applicants must first meet the eligibility criteria. The committee will deliberate on the merits of each candidate's demonstrated character and responses to the writing prompts. The scholarship will be awarded to the candidate whom the committee determines best embodies Trevor's passion for sports, leadership, and community spirit.
